PILOT



Deploying with a sector-leading multinational

URBAN DRINKING WATER CHALLENGE 2018

- \$1 million competition to deploy decentralized drinking water solutions globally launched (May '18).

- 18 international startups showcased at IH2O-led pavilion at Aquatech China, Asia's largest water trade show.

IH20 WATER GALA '18



Imagine H2O's annual showcase event in March celebrates the Accelerator companies and introduces them to 350+ members of IH2O's network. Sponsored by Salesforce, Water Gala '18 attracted industry leaders from across the country.



IH2O/WATER ENVIRONMENT FEDERATION INNOVATION FORUM

On Thursday of SF Week, Imagine H2O holds the annual Innovation Forum alongside WEF. In 2018, 130 senior water executives gathered to discuss Deployment for Impact in the water sector. Accelerator companies pitch to the crowd, lead roundtable discussions with issue experts, and network with potential partners, customers and investors. In 2018, Accelerator companies reported 168 actionable connections from the day.

Accelerator: IH2O SF Week March 2019



All companies participate in a week-long water innovation bootcamp culminating in the annual Imagine H2O Water Gala. IH2O SF Week is the only time participants are required to be in San Francisco. Participants benefit from interactive workshops, one-one-consultations with customers, investors and IH2O alumni, as well as working with each other.


MENTORSHIP

IH2O matches each participant throughout the year with 4 dedicated mentors drawn from the organization's mentor network of 60+ industry experts and thought leaders. IH2O works closely with each participant to identify the appropriate mentor as company needs and priorities evolve throughout the program.

INNOVATION PAVILIONS

Since 2011, IH2O has hosted annual innovation pavilions at the largest drinking water and wastewater trade conferences both in the US and abroad. IH2O showcases its portfolio companies as well as spearheads workshops and pitch sessions to raise awareness about the water innovation opportunity. Thousands of delegates visit the innovation pavilions every year.





ONLINE LEARNING AND ENGAGEMENT

IH2O designs and hosts invite-only webinars throughout the year for its portfolio companies and network of customers and strategic partners. This includes live pitches and capacity development sessions. Examples of recent webinars include: Selling to Utilities; Managing Channel Partners; Building a Data Company in Water; Understanding Term Sheets; Raising Money in Water.

DEPLOYMENT FOR IMPACT

IH2O serves as a customer validation platform, providing 2018 accelerator companies with 39 deployments year to date. In 2018, IH2O will offer deployment awards to pilot technologies in underserved markets in the U.S.. This program will expand in 2019, including a range of potential activities linking Accelerator companies to new markets globally.


