On the 11th of December 2020, the Final Workshop of the VI Cycle of Utility Benchmarking Program (UBP) in Ukraine for Ukrainian water and sanitation utilities will be held virtually. This workshop aims at summarizing the results of the current UBP cycle and connecting all utilities participating in the program.
