The new Danube Water Program KnowNow webinar series focuses on up-to-date topics relevant for the water sector in the Danube region. The first edition will focus on the revised EU Drinking Water Directive 2020/2184 that has entered into force in January 2021 aiming to provide better access to high quality water for human consumption, including for vulnerable groups. This is in response to the demands of over 1.8 million Europeans who signed the first-ever successful European Citizens' Initiative, "Right2Water", in support of improving access to safe drinking water for all Europeans.
